

## **Discipleship Self-evaluation**

When you became a Christian you made a decision to follow Jesus, to be His disciple. So how are you doing? Use the checklist below to evaluate the quality of your “followship.”

### **Time with God:**

- Quantity and quality time with God in prayer, Bible study, and worship
- The relationship is fostered daily

### **Consistent obedience:**

- “Yes” to God; “no” to sin
- Seek God’s guidance in all you do
- You have a desire to please God

### **In the world, but not of it:**

- Actively in the world sharing your faith through word and deed
- You don’t look like the world
- You intentionally befriend the lost
- You have a passion to tell others about Jesus

### **Service:**

- You are serving others, in the church and out
- You serve in practical ways as God leads
- You serve with your time, money, gifts, and talents

### **Consistency:**

- Your faith permeates every area of your life (church, work, social, recreation)
- Your life is not compartmentalized into “religious” and “non-religious”
- Jesus is your life and it shows

### **Christian Fellowship:**

- You are vitally connected with a body of believers
- You do life together
- You hold each other accountable for your walk with Christ
