When God's grace flows through us and out of our mouths, our words will encourage, edify, build up, and give grace to those who hear them. #LavishGrace

Our words reflect the condition and content of our hearts. Insecurities, hurt, pride, defensiveness, fear, greed, and more can produce “ungracious” words. #LavishGrace #PassTheGrace

Sometimes Christians stingily hoard God’s grace as if the supply will soon run dry. Either we forget the nature of God’s grace or our understanding needs to be expanded. God calls us to be people of grace relating to others with love, humility, and selflessness. But too often, pride and selfishness hinder our relationships. #LavishGrace #PassTheGrace

God’s choice to love us was the ultimate act of grace. “But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us” Romans 5:8.

The world tells us to make ourselves look good... to put ourselves first... to make sure our own needs are met... to save the best for ourselves. But God tells us to use Jesus as our model... to act with humility... to seek the welfare of others... to meet their needs. #LavishGrace #PassTheGrace

“Grace” is... giving to the undeserving... doing with no expectation of return... showing kindness to those who have hurt us... meeting the needs of those who will can’t help us. #LavishGrace #PassTheGrace

“Grace” is not stingy or choosy. It does not hoard or withhold itself from the underserving or those who desperately need it. #LavishGrace #PassTheGrace

“Grace” leaves no room for expectation or return. Grace freely gives to those who have no ability to invite, to give, to help, to offer – the orphan, the widow, the homeless, the invalid, the dying. #LavishGrace #PassTheGrace

Let us share the Gospel with grace, behaving and speaking in ways that connect with others and honor Jesus. #LavishGrace #PassTheGrace
